TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

BE IT KNOWN, THAT THIS DAY THE PRESIDENT HAS GRANTED UNTO

ROGER CASSIDY CLINTON

A FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL PARDON

FOR HIS CONVICTIONS in the United States District Court for the Western District of Arkansas on an indictment (Docket No. 84-60009-01) charging violation of Section 846, Title 21, United States Code, for which he was sentenced on January twenty-eighth, 1985, to two years' imprisonment, and on an indictment (Docket No. 84-60008-01) charging violation of Section 841(a)(1), Title 21, United States Code, for which he was sentenced on January twenty-eighth, 1985, as modified on June twenty-fourth, 1998, to three years' probation to commence after the completion of the term of imprisonment imposed in Docket No. 84-60009-01.

THE PRESIDENT HAS DESIGNATED, directed and empowered the Pardon Attorney as his representative to sign this grant of executive clemency.

In accordance with these instructions and authority I have signed my name and caused the seal of the Department of Justice to be affixed hereto and affirm that this action is the act of the President being performed at his direction.
