CRIMINAL INFORMATION

COUNT ONE

(Conspiracy to Provide Material Support & Resources to al Qaeda)

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

From in or about late 2000 to in or about March 2003, the defendant, IYMAN FARIS, within the United States and subject to the jurisdiction of the United States, did unlawfully and knowingly combine, conspire, confederate, and agree with other persons, known and unknown, to provide material support and resources, as that term is defined in 18 U.S.C. § 2339A(b), to a foreign terrorist organization, namely al Qaeda.

(In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2339B and 371.)

COUNT TWO

(Providing Material Support & Resources to al Qaeda)

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

From in or about late 2000 to in or about March 2003, the defendant, IYMAN FARIS, subject to the jurisdiction of the United States, but outside of the jurisdiction of any particular state or district, did unlawfully and knowingly provide material support and resources, as that term is defined in 18 U.S.C. §2339A(b), to a foreign terrorist organization, namely al Qaeda. (In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2339B.)
