This cause came on for hearing and was heard this 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2003, before the Judge James R. Williams, upon motion of the plaintiff for a Temporary Restraining Order. The plaintiff seeks an order restraining defendants, their officers, members, agents, servants, employees, attorneys and those acting in active concert or participation with them from certain conduct and activities, pending further hearing on plaintiff's complaint for preliminary and permanent injunctive relief, and upon plaintiff's verified complaint, affidavits, and argument of counsel.

Upon consideration whereof, being fully advised in the premises, the Courts finds that the defendants and their counsel were given notice of plaintiff's intention to move herein for a temporary restraining order, and further finds that plaintiff's motion is well taken and that it clearly appears that plaintiff will suffer immediate and irreparable injury unless a temporary restraining order issues, and that the plaintiff is entitled to a restraining order against the defendants as hereinafter set forth:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that until February 19, 2003, or such time as is necessary for the Court to

hold a hearing and determining of plaintiff's application for a preliminary injunction, defendants and each and all of them, their officers, agents, members and employees and those in active concert and participation with said defendants and all other persons to whom knowledge of this order shall come, be and hereby are enjoined and restrained from:

Taking or enforcing any action or order based upon the January 31, 2003 decision by Clair Muscaro declaring Lebron James ineligible as an amateur athlete, or otherwise restraining, preventing or precluding him from participation in interscholastic athletics for the remainder of the 2002-2003 varsity basketball season and playoffs. Lebron James eligibility is restored as of this day, February 5, 2003, and he can begin practicing with the team. The plaintiff, Lebron James, will be suspended for an additional game, and Defendant St. Vincent St. Mary will select the game and inform the court by February 6, 2003. The status of the previous game, which was declared forfeited, remains unchanged.

The Court will hold a hearing on February 19, 2003 at 9:00 am, on plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction. The plaintiff is not required to furnish a bond for these proceedings.
