RESPONSE TO GOVERNMENT'S MOTION TO CLARIFY

The government seeks permission to provide recently produced discovery materials to Oklahoma State authorities so that discovery can be provided to state defense counsel. Mr. McVeigh does not object to release of the recently produced materials, subject to the protective order in this case that prohibits public dissemination of discovery documents. The problems created by the government's untimely production of discovery materials in this case should not be visited upon the parties in the Oklahoma proceeding. Therefore, subject to the preexisting protective order in this case, Mr. McVeigh does not oppose the government's effort to make all discovery materials available to the Oklahoma authorities and state defense counsel.
