Enclosed you will find a check from my campaign committee in the amount of \$50,000, which represents the total of Oracle Corporation contributions made to my campaign during my term in office. I am glad that Oracle has in the past supported my philosophy, my policy and my actions on behalf of California since my election as California Attorney General, but in an abundance of caution and in order to ensure that there is not the slightest appearance of a conflict in the conduct of my official responsibilities, I have decided to return donations from Oracle Corporation. The claims surrounding donations by Oracle to my campaign have become a distraction, moving public attention from the issues that should matter most to the people of California. Returning these funds will help focus public attention and public policy makers on the procurement processes of state government that may require reform, and bolster public confidence in our inquiry into whether any laws were broken in the making of the contract.

In taking this action, I want to assure you that I am not now expressing an opinion or judgment with regard to Oracle Corporation's conduct, business practices or policies or those of its employees or agents.
